

The Organisation Status

Siliguri Suryanagar Samaj-kalyan Sanstha (4s) is a voluntary organisation registered under the societies registration act 1961. We presently hold the secretariate office of the Federation of Voluntary Blood Donor Organisation of West Bengal, India. We have our expertise in Voluntary Blood Donor Motivation, Recruitment & Training of Donor Motivators and Social Workers.

Areas of Activities

Different social organisation, Clubs, Educational Institutes, NCC, NSS, Business Organisations, Corporate Sectors, Professional groups, Self help Groups, Polytechnics, University of North Bengal.



Success Stories

While we organise a variety of programmes like Voluntary Blood Donation camps, Blood Donor Awareness Programme, free Medical Camps etc. each year, some of our most enduring and successful annual programme have been linked to:



Promotion of voluntary blood donation:-

Promotion of voluntary blood Donation and safe blood transfusion service through awareness camps, seminars, workshops, school education programmes, Sub-divisional level certificate courses, College NSS Unit Education programmes. We organise blood donation camps throughout the year. AIDS awareness programmes, Thalasseamia Awareness programmes, are some of our activities round the year.





Awareness camp:

Every year we organize at least 70-80 awareness camps throughout north Bengal with the help of sister organizations and various govt. & private sectors offices. Specially trained faculty members attend those camps.





Seminar:

Seminars are organised from time to time with eminent persons, doctors & social workers having good experience in social service.





Workshop:

We organize workshop for improvement of quality of existing members of our organization as well as members of other organizations for imparting advanced motivation strategies. This has resulted in increase in the number of dedicated volunteers.

Student Programmes:

Children are more idealistic than adults. They are the blood donors of tomorrow. In our school programmes, children too young to donate blood, encourage their parents and relatives to donate blood. Students motivated by our programme, have started donating on attaining the age of 18 years and some of them have become organizers of camps.









School Education Programme:

Every year, we conduct school education programme for school students (class XI and above). It is a one hour lecture followed by interactive session. We are able to reach 20-25 schools annually for imparting scientific knowledge & AIDS







Certificate course on blood donor motivation & safe blood transfusion:

We offer certificate course to various voluntary organizations of north Bengal throughout the year. Trainees should have passed 10 standards or above. The course contains scientific method of blood donors motivation & recruitment. Total 9 hours study is spread over three days duration. Trained faculty members who can extensively travel various part of North Bengal are chosen as volunteers to conduct these courses.





EXHIBITION

Exhibition of IEC material is one of the effective weapons of awareness campaign for voluntary blood donation and safe blood transfusion. Details of scientific facts and figures has to be made available to the people to make them agree to donate blood voluntarily. The IEC materials are designed in such a way that anyone who goes through the informations properly, never miss any opportunity to save a life by donating blood . The exhibition works as self motivator











The exhibition includes:

- Information about history of evolution of blood transfusion system, since past 400 years.
 - Educational information on blood science and scientific basis behind the blood donation. This nullify all age old superstations that blood donation causes harm to one's health and elinminate fear by logical explanations.
- Inspiring massages that touch the heart of the viewer.
 - Exposure to different type of materials of recognition that is given to the blood donors

This type of colourful exhibition is conducted in different occasions like Mela, Health Awareness Programme, Science Exhibition, during annual programme of schools, colleges as well as Universities or any festival organised by clubs, ceremonial get together, religious programmes etc.etc.







Blood donation camp :-

We Organise blood donation camps throughout the year. We also organise special camps when there is scarcity at blood banks.

OUR OTHER ACTIVITIES







Free Medical camp for poor and needy people:

Free medical camp is being run by our organisation twice a week for poor and needy patients of slums and adjoining areas. We have few dedicated medical officers who have volunteered themselves in this service. Physiotherapy, ECG & X-ray are also part of our service to the society.



Immunisation Camps:

Low Cost Pathological Laboratory:

We have a low cost Pathological Lab. for poor and needy patients open 365 days of the year. The cost of Pathological Lab was donated by Janpath Samachar, Siliguri.



Low Cost X-RAY Unit:

We have a low cost X-Ray Unit for poor and needy patients. The machine was donated by M/s. Calcutta Metropoliton Group. Janpath Samachar along with other social minded people made their contribution to build up the X-Ray room.



GENERAL HEALTH CHECK UP & SOCIAL AWARENESS PROGRAMMES AMONG THE TEA GARDEN WORKERS OF NORTH BENGAL



We undertake regular check-up camps in remote tea garden areas where anaemia, malnutrition is very much prevalent. Diseases like malaria, tuber culosis, jaundice kill many workers every year. Awarness programmes to fight superstition and witchery, cleanliness, disease protection drives are undertaken



Relief and rescue operations:

- 1993 : We sent flood relief team to the flood affected people of ALIPURDUAR areas with administration support. We reached to about ten thousand flood victims with relief material like baby food, garments, daily necessities and medical team with doctors.
- 1995 : A flood relief team was sent to ITAHAR BALURGHAT for the flood affected people and served about 5000 people in association with local administration.
- 1998: We spent one month in MALDA with flood relief materials and an ideal medical team with 5 doctors. We have covered KALIACHAK, the worst effected area.
- 2000: In association with few voluntary organizations, we provided relief to the flood affected people of MURSHIDABAD district.
- 2002: We sent Medical assistance and relief materials to the affected people of Landslide areas in MIRIK BLOCK and GAYABARI on Darjeeling hills.
- 2006: Rescue & Relief for Bomb blast victims of the train at Belakoba railway station.
- 2007 : Rescue work for Bhramhaputra Mail accident victims at Nijbari.
- 2010: Medical guidance was given to the people affected with one type of culture bound syndrome named "KORO" disease and fought against local superstition regarding this disease in affected area of Jalpaiguri and Darjeeling District of West Bengal.
- 2011: Rescue operation undertaken for the Darjeeling Bijonbari Bridge digester







Physical service assistance to the civic Administration

Our volunteers participated in assisting the civic administration during the time of epidemic fever spread in Siliguri in the year of 2001.


